Electoral Roll 2019

Registration on the electoral roll is entirely voluntary but enables you to vote at the annual meeting (APCM) and to stand for election to the PCC. Even if you are on the current roll, you still need to complete application forms this year for the new roll.

Application forms are available in church. You can also apply online from the St Bots website if you prefer. Click on the "*Electoral Roll 2019*" link on the home page. Qualifying criteria are explained on the forms.

We are privileged to have Roger Carswell as the principal speaker.

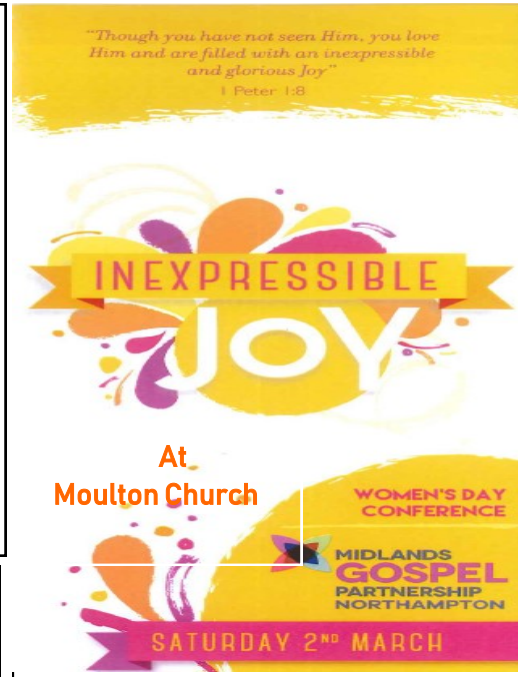
The venue will again be the Frontier Centre at Irthlingborough. More details soon.
