Leah Sharibu



Leah was one of 110 girls abducted from their school in Dapchi, Nigeria by ISWAP (an offshoot of Boko Haram) in February 2018. The next month, following negotiations by the government, the surviving girls were put into vehicles to go home.

However, Leah wasn't among them. She wasn't released because she refused to convert in exchange for her freedom. Leah 17th birthday is on 14th May.

Please keep persevering in prayer until we see Leah freed, along with all those held by terrorist factions in north-east Nigeria.

In summary, please pray:

- That Leah and all other hostages would be released.
- For God to protect them from the terrors of their surroundings.
- That the Lord will be a refuge and a comfort to Nathan, Rebecca and Donald Sharibu and every family like Leah's, awaiting the return of their loved ones.
- For divine protection for villages in central Nigeria, and the release of those abducted for ransom.
- For CSW's work, particularly with the UK government, at the UN, EU and in Nigeria itself, to challenge the government to address the ongoing crisis.

Man up ? Battling depression as a Christian

In this time of lockdown, mental health comes under a great deal of pressure. Its therefore imperative, now more than ever, that we as churches are able to support those facing mental health struggles. We're therefore very grateful to have the opportunity to hear from PJ Appleton about depression and his own experience, hosted by **Moulton men's ministry** on Zoom.

PJ lives in London with his wife Claudia where he works as a Communications Director for an Australian technology company. He has been a Christian since giving his life to Jesus at 13 and now attends Christ Church Mayfair. At aged 24, he was diagnosed with depression, something he still battles on and off today. Over the past six years, he has given a number of talks (both in secular and Christian environments) about his experiences with depression and what it means to suffer with mental health struggles as a Christian.
