Last year, 4,031 people could not access CAP's help as appointments were fully booked or there was no centre nearby. To meet the increasing need, we need to double the number of people we can see through a growing network of churches. To make the necessary changes now, we urgently need to raise £1.9 million. Otherwise, we'll be forced to turn away more and more people in need.

When I first met Jim, he'd fallen into debt after having to give up work due to ill health, his family home had been repossessed and his marriage had ended due to the strain of financial worries. He'd become totally isolated, living alone in unsuitable emergency accommodation, relying on Universal Credit to survive, drowning in debt. I said to Jim, 'From this day forward, you are not alone,' and I immediately saw the weight begin to lift. I can't bear to imagine where Jim might be now if we'd had to turn him away.




### What's on at St Edmund's


