Message from St Botolph's Church Wardens given at the APCM 24th May

We have been blessed over the past 14 months with our leadership team of Mark, Andy and Helen who have gone more than the extra mile in constantly reminding us through Morning Prayer, Sunday services, Thoughts for the Day and other prayer times of just how much our Saviour loves us, how much mercy he has shown and how much grace he has showered us with.

To do so all three have had to learn new skills in utilising advances in on-line technology which has enabled them all to bring us God's word remotely, and I hope all would agree that their learning has enabled them to improve our service presentation each week.

However, Peter and I have been very aware of the stress and strain that all three have been under to produce the on-line material each week. In addition Andy has continued to engage with the youth at least twice a week either face to face in the marguee in Church House garden or on-line and Helen has met with the younger members.

So we have approached the Bishop and asked if he would be prepared to grant Mark and Andy an extra fortnight's holiday to add on to their planned holidays this summer. We are pleased to report that the Bishop replied immediately in the affirmative and said that he had, in fact only very recently, urged both of them to take extra holiday in recognition of their efforts through the pandemic to enable them to take a complete break and recharge their batteries.

Mark felt that as Helen's workload had been no less onerous that she, too should have a long break. The upshot is that all three will be off for a month, Mark and Andy at different times, over July and August. To enable this, Mark has arranged cover for all the services whilst they are away and that in August there will only be one service a Sunday at Barton. The 11.00am service at Warkton will also continue.

Peter and I are certain that this is right, and we would urge everyone to be in prayer for all three asking that the rest will be beneficial and enable all three to return in September fully refreshed and ready for another years' ministry.
