Otherwise, we'll be forced to turn away more and more people in need.

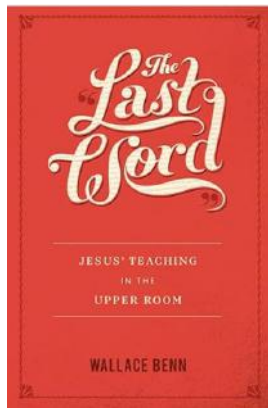

He'd become totally isolated, living alone in unsuitable emergency accommodation, relying on Universal Credit to survive, drowning in debt. I said to Jim, **'From this day forward, you are not alone,'** and I immediately saw the weight begin to lift. **I can't bear to imagine where Jim might be now if we'd had to turn him away.**

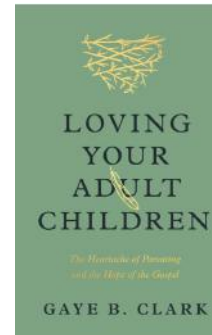

As kids grow, so do the pains of parenthood. Patterns of miscommunication and resentment can cause damage over the years, leaving parents and adult children with a fractured relationship. Confused, hurt, and sometimes angry, mums and dads can struggle to know where to turn for help and where to look for hope.

With grace and empathy, author Gaye B. Clark comes alongside readers bearing the weight of parenthood. Encouraging readers to view themselves as image bearers of God first and parents second, Clark shifts readers' focus to their relationship with Christ while showing how the relationship between parent and child can be a catalyst for understanding the gospel. *Loving Your Adult Children* examines the fruit of the Spirit in relation to parenting adult children, offers study questions for reflection, and shows how walking with God is the best next step for struggling parents.
